

**Minutes 14 April 2009**  
**Special Meeting of the Yancey County Board of Commissioners**  
**Held at 5:00 o'clock p.m. in the Commissioner's Meeting Room**  
**Yancey County Courthouse, Burnsville, North Carolina**

Present at the 14 April 2009 special meeting of the Yancey County Board of County Commissioners were Walter Savage, Chairman, Members Johnny Riddle and Jerri Storie, Assistant Clerk to the Board Nathan Bennett, and members of the general public.


Chairman Savage called the meeting to order and proceeded to ask for the addition of a single item to the agenda, that being a resolution recognizing the EnergyXchange and its 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary. Motion to approve the agenda as amended was made by Commissioner Riddle and the motion was seconded by Commissioner Storie. The vote to approve was unanimous. 


Having no further business Commissioner Riddle made a motion to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded by Commissioner Storie. The motion passed unanimously.


