Yancey County seeks statements of qualifications from firms capable of providing engineering, planning, and construction inspection services. The County has received funding from NC Department of Environmental Quality (NCDEQ) from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) for a water and sewer line extension on the West Burnsville Industrial Site this project totaling \$2,730,910.

Yancey County is requesting statements of qualification for professional engineering services, including, but not limited to, developing a final engineering report, subsequent engineering, design, permitting, bid package services, and construction inspection services for the scope of work identified in the associated Request for Qualifications issued regarding this project, in compliance with all applicable federal requirements and regulations under the ARPA program.
